

How to Register as a Supplier on e-tenders.ie

****NOTE: When registering as a Supplier on the eTender system it may at first sight appear that you have to be a registered company to do so. This, however, is not the case. The Law Reform Commission invites applications from companies, sole traders, academics, researchers or anyone who can demonstrate expertise in one or more of the categories.****

To participate in calls to tender with the Office of Government Procurement you must first register yourself or your business as a supplier. If you have never previously registered as a supplier, then go to the homepage <https://etenders.gov.ie> and click on 'Register yourself and your organisation as a Supplier on the system' (circled below). This will bring you to the first step of the registration process.

In order to register your interest in a tender go to the homepage at <https://etenders.gov.ie> and login in by clicking on the Login button in the top right corner of the screen:



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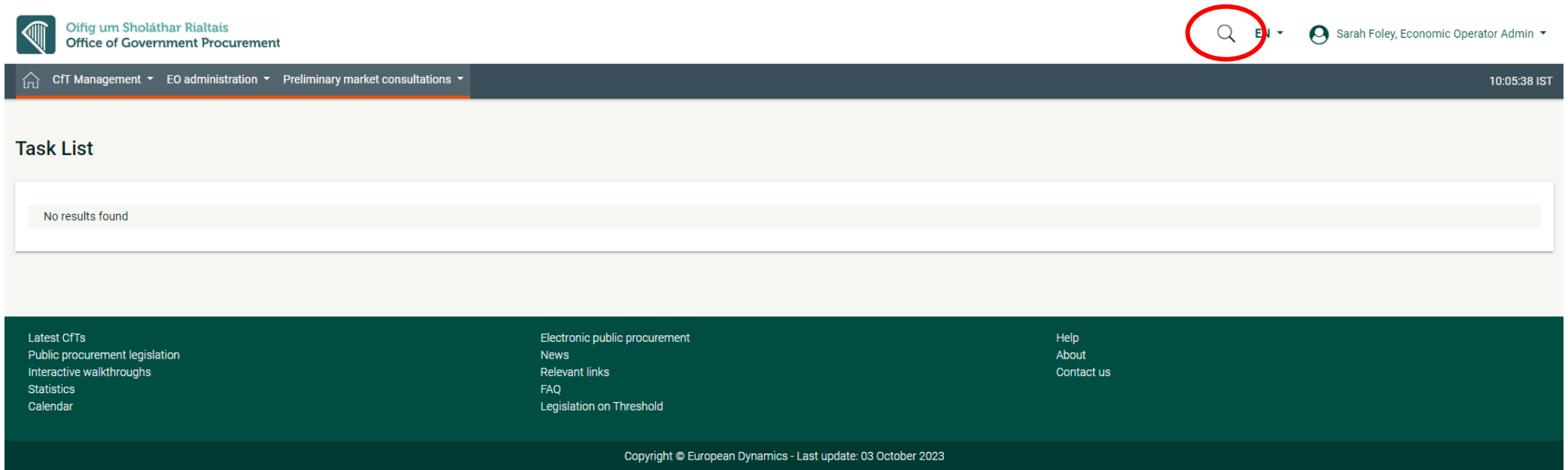

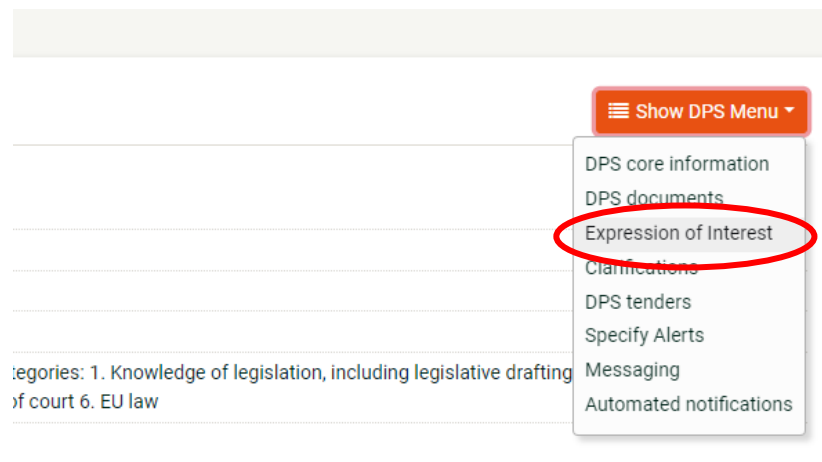

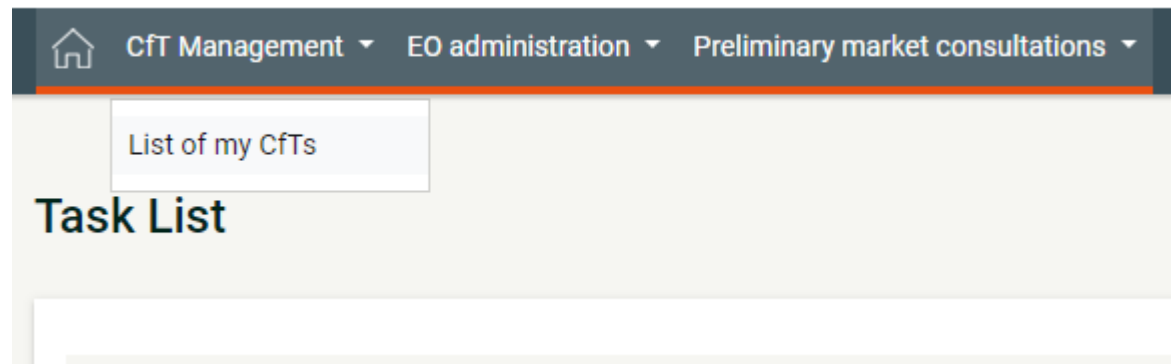
